What it is

Clever-backstory alert: Director Bradley Rust Gray is married to So Yong Kim, whose much-admired 2006 debut, In Between Days, takes its name from a Cure single. Gray's film is titled after the B-side. Set during a sweltering Brooklyn summer, The Exploding Girl stars sad-eyed film royalty Zoe Kazan as a university student home for vacation and working through doldrums.
